Working at Heights

Maintenance works are usually linked to working at heights; this implies that the safe work methods to be adopted should follow practices like using certified portable ladders, wearing safety harnesses, using tool belts etc. very often however, maintenance personnel bypass those requirements especially when they judge that the duration of the work is limited. However, never forget that the fall's consequences can never be predicted as the result can range from a near-miss to death.
